YMCA CERTIFICATION CLASS*

This course is designed to provide participants the knowledge and skills necessary to be a lifeguard and professional rescuer. Participants will be certified in American Safety and Health Institute's (ASHI) courses: Basic Life Saving, Basic First Aid for the Community, and Emergency Oxygen Admin.

*Ages 16 or older | On the first day, bring a photo I.D. and be prepared to swim. Participants must pass the Physical Competency Requirements conducted on the first day.

Course Fee \$250 (reduced to \$175 for those pre-qualified to work at the Y, and reimbursable after clocking 350 hours as a Y lifeguard); must attend full 37 hr. course and pass a written/skills tests to successfully complete certification.
